Dear Well-wisher of Anjuman-I-Islam, Assalamo Alaykum!

Ramazan Mubarak to you and your family members. May this month bring Amaan, Aafiyat and Barakaat to you all. Anjuman-I-Islam is the largest minority educational and social institution focusing on the very marginalized sections of society and is all-inclusive in implementing its objectives. It manages about 97 institutions and at any one point of time it provides education to approximately one lakh students with administrative and teaching staff of 3000 to ensure quality education to these students. Brief of Anjuman-i-Islam is attached. Anjuman-I-Islam is registered as a Company under Section 8 of the Companies Act and is also registered as a trust under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950.

Anjuman-I-Islam, works on two objectives, providing good education at least possible cost, and ensuring that the poorest of poor has the opportunity to get educated. Towards these objectives, we have been keeping our costs under control, at the same time ensuring that our teaching faculties are well equipped with modern tools to impart education of the highest standard. Many of our students come from the poorest of the poor strata of Society and to ensure education for them, we raise resources through government scholarships and private donations for their fees, uniforms, books, transportation, etc. In the year 2019-20, we raised a decent sum from various sources but even after this, there was a shortfall which we just could not meet.

Anjuman-I-Islam is running a significant and important project called 'SAHARA project'. We request you to consider supporting us in this project. Primarily this project is addressing the needs of thousands of very poor students, mostly first generation learners, of pre-primary to professional colleges, who do not have any wherewithal for payment of the fees, basic needs, books, educational material, uniforms, transportation cost and other necessary skills to live a better life as effective members of the society. There are two SAHARA Units located at Mahim and SAHARA Sponsorship Project and Skill Development Centre at Mumbra. These units address the needs of these students. In addition, also, there is a SAHARA Unit for Destitute Women and Child Welfare, which addresses the needs of destitute women, divorced mothers, victims of broken homes and the marginalized by providing counselling and running short term occupational courses which help them to earn a living and makes them selfsustainable.

We run two orphanages for girls, at Mumbai and Pune, where the girls are well looked after, educated and finally settled in marriage after rigorous inquiries to ensure and safeguard their future.

With the current lockdown, many of the labourers, daily wage earners, small business people, marginal employees, have lost their livelihood and are in dire financial condition. Thus, in the year 2020-21, we anticipate that the students needing financial help will rise substantially.

It is under these circumstances that I am approaching you with a request to consider Anjuman-I-Islam as a beneficiary of your generous donation/Zakat this Ramazan. Needless to add your contributions made upto 30th June, 2020 would be eligible for exemption under Section 80G for the financial year 19-20.

ABOUT ANJUMAN-I-ISLAM, MUMBAI

From modest beginnings, the Anjuman-I-Islam has flowered into a singular institution, unsurpassed in its efforts to spread education to the marginalized sections of the Society.

Anjuman-I-Islam has over a period of time since its inception grown by leaps and bounds, continuing to give quality education to its students. Today it runs 97 institutions and at any one time approximately one lakh students derive benefit from the education imparted by these institutions. It has about 3000 teaching and administrative staff who make these efforts a success.

Anjuman-I-Islam was founded in the year 1874 in Bombay (now Mumbai), by a small group of progressive Muslims led by Justice Badruddin Tyabji, the third President of Indian National Congress and the First Indian Chief Justice of Bombay High Court. Those were turbulent times, when waves of freedom and nationalism were sweeping through the country and the visionary, Justice Badruddin Tyabji understood that education was the key to building the nation's pride and restoring its erstwhile glory. It was also the beginning of a movement to support the Muslim community's advance in education and social standing.

Anjuman-I-Islam began with one school and has grown in size and scope to encompass over 97 educational and other institutions, ranging from pre-primary schools to graduate, postgraduate and research centers. Subjects at these institutions span the gamut of educational disciplines, from engineering and business management to architecture, pharmacy, law, medicine and hotel management and catering.

Anjuman-I-Islam is in the frontline for empowerment of women. The first school for girls was established in 1939 whose principal was Ms. Annie Samson, Vice Principal was Mrs. Najoo Bharucha, Head Teacher was Ms. V.V. Parulekar. In the year 1941 it opened its second school for girls, at Bandra, which was headed by Ms. Mathai. This brings out the very roots of inclusiveness of Anjuman-I-Islam. About 85% of the currently teaching staff are ladies. A majority of Heads of Institutes i.e. H.M's, Principals, Directors are also ladies.

Anjuman-I-Islam is a Registered Company under Section 8 of Company's Act. Anjuman-I-Islam Charities is registered under Charity Commissioner Mumbai, Registration no. B-610 (BOM) dated 1/4/1953, Certificate of Registration No. 1615 BB-19-399.

Though a Muslim minority organization, Anjuman-I-Islam has a clear 'open door' policy of welcoming students from all communities – thus contributing in no small measure towards national integrity and nation building. Currently the needs of approximately one lakh students from various communities are met with sincerity. We are thankful to an unswerving focus on transparency and the highest quality education being inculcated by all Anjuman-I-Islam fraternity.

Anjuman-I-Islam has achieved the status of a world class Educational and Social Service Organization. In addition to its educational institutions, Anjuman-I-Islam runs orphanages, hostels and social service centers for the underprivileged. It also manages 15 Trusts.

Among the many precious jewels in Anjuman-I-Islam's crown of educational offerings and achievements are the renowned Karimi Library housed in the Mumbai headquarters; winning the Maharashtra Government's prestigious 'State Award 2000' for excellence in education and social service; and distinguished alumni who have excelled in diverse fields. Our students consistently ranked 2nd at international level in Advanced class in Design Report and ranked 3rd in Micro Class Design Report in SAE AERODESIGN East-2015 at Lakeland, Florida, USA from among 75 teams from all over the globe.
- Engineering students received the INCUBATEE award and seed fund of Rs. 20 Lakh in India Innovation Challenge 2016 organized by Texas Instruments in collaboration with Department of Science and Technology (DST), IIM Bangalore, Make in India.
- Engineering students received a research grant of Rs. 10 Lakh in India Innovation Growth Program 2.0, University Challenge 2017, organized by a public private partnership between Department of Science and Technology (DST), Lockheed Martin corporation and Tata trust for promoting innovation. Project prototype was Electronic Arm (HATH: Hands AT Help).

- Our Engineering students consistently winning I, II & III prizes in all Technical festivals organized by IIT Bombay, Kanpur and Gandhinagar for the last 5 years.
- Two of our inmates of **Orphanage did MBA** and working with NSDL as a Senior Manager and as a Deputy Manager in ICICI Bank. Another **orphan did her B.Sc. (Nursing)** and working in Infection Control department with Dhirubhai Ambani hospital.
- Our students Won Gold and Bronze Medals, in the prestigious **National Chef Competition GICC (Great Indian Culinary Challenge)** and also won Silver medal in the **Nestle Student Chef Championship** organized by WICA - WESTERN INDIA CULINARY ASSOCIATION. Also, our students were integral part in **"Master Chef Competition"**.
- Our Architecture 9 students got selected for MCHI CREDAI scholarship of Rs. 50000/- per year till they pass out.
- Our many Alumni of Engineering and Pharmacy despite coming from a challenging backgrounds established their own Enterprises like Octaware Technologies M/s Micromedix Pharmaceuticals.
- Consistent **Rank holders** in the University of Mumbai, SNDT University and MSBTE in the fields of Engineering, B. Ed. and Home Science.
